Work Day Information

Crew Size: 12 people maximum
Age Requirement: Minimum 16 years old. No exceptions.

Safety: All volunteers should be physically fit, able to stand for long periods, lift at least 25 lbs, maneuver on concrete floor or uneven ground, bend & stoop and carry heavy and/or awkward items for a full work day.

Waiver of Liability: Required by all volunteers. Waivers expire annually on December 31st. Minors **MUST** have a parent signature on **our waiver** - school or individual notes/permission slips will not be accepted.

Construction:

Tuesday – Saturday 8:00am – 4:00pm
NO HALF DAYS

Volunteers age 16-17 must have a parent or adult guardian working with them for the full day.

Building sites can be dangerous places! **All construction volunteers** must complete the on-line safety course, "[Volunteering on a Habitat for Humanity Job Site](#)" before coming to a build site.

Be prepared to work inside or out, rain or shine, to work hard & get dirty! No sandals/open-toed shoes. No dangly jewelry or scarves.

Volunteers are assigned to available tasks including foundations, siding, insulation, painting, landscaping, clean-up. **Every job is important!**
