Her living conditions are deplorable.

The mold situation impacts her sons’ asthma every day. The gang and drug activity occurring outside her apartment even during COVID make it unsafe for her and her children to even go out for a walk.

Jasmine is one of the future homeowner’s partnering with Habitat for Humanity Lake County. Her 8-year-old son had prayed to God for a future home and was so excited. Now, more than ever, we are committed to building her and her family a home.
